Cherub and Choralier Choirs

meet as part of Wednesday Connection - Wednesdays, 3:00—5:00 PM

Cherub Choir

For children aged 4 (by September 1) through 1st grade meets on Wednesdays, September through May, singing in church periodically and on Christmas Eve.

Choralier Choir

For children in grades 2-5 meets on Wednesdays, September through May. They sing periodically in worship, and present a special program at Christmas along with a musical on Mother's Day.

Youth Music and Arts

Middle School Fellowship meets on Wednesdays and includes music to be shared in worship. All youth are welcome to share musical gifts through solo singing, the playing of instruments, and, periodically, Family Handbells with parents.

Chancel Choir

All are welcome to join the choral ensemble that most frequently leads the music portion of worship while also offering friendships, the joy of singing, and the art of sacred music. Rehearsals occur on Wednesdays at 6:45 PM, September through April.

Summer Choir

All are welcome to this choir that rehearses and sings on Sundays from June thru August.
