






Presbyterian Women


Each luncheon features a local speaker, table mission offering, musical selection and tasty catered meal.

Today's Music: As they did with Mendelssohn's Six Organ Sonatas last season, Chris Dekker and John Stansell will be presenting some of Bach's organ chorale preludes one Sunday each month of this season. Today's selections have two settings of a some what familiar tune, Wer nur den lieben Gott, that can be found at # 617 in our hymnal. The first is from the so-called Schlübler Chorals and the postlude from the Orgel büchlein (Little Organ Book). The chorale prelude Nun danket alle Gott is based on the well known tune Now Thank We All Our God. This setting comes from the set of cho rales known as The Great Eighteen Leipzig Chorales. All three of these are relatively straightforward settings where the melody is clearly heard. For more background, one can refer to the short article John has written, available in the narthex or from an usher.
