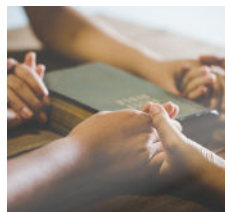
Today's Music: This morning's prelude is performed by Moorings member Leila Arshed, and we heartily thank her for her willingness to share her talents with the congregation. Lelia has been playing the piano since she was four years old, and also plays the violin and is now learning to play the guitar.

This morning's postlude is an arrangements of the historic Gregorian chant tune *Veni Creator Spiritus*, arranged by French Classical composer Nicolas de Grigny (1672–1703). Written in the late 8th century, this Latin text is directly translated as: "Come, Holy Ghost, Creator blest, and in our hearts take up thy rest; come with thy grace and heavenly aid, to fill the hearts which thou hast made." The chant melody has been arranged hundreds of times for organ, choir, and many other orchestrations, and remains popular at Pentecost at churches around the world.

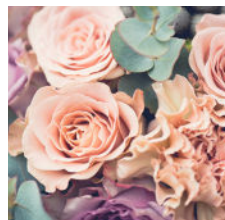
