Today's Music While many enduring hymns are born out of a particular dramatic experience, the writing of *Great Is Thy Faithfulness* was simply the result of the author's realization of God's goodness throughout life. Thomas Chisholm, the hymn's author, wrote the following shortly before his death in 1960: "My income has never been large at any time due to impaired health in the earlier years which has followed me on until now. But I must not fail to record here the unfailing faithfulness of a covenant-keeping God and that he has given me many wonderful displays of his providing care which have filled me with astonishing gratefulness." Chisholm, born in a poor, small Kentucky town, began his career as a school teacher (despite never having graduated from high school), but later became a Methodist minister. Chisholm wrote more than 1,200 sacred poems, many of which have become well-known hymns.
